



The problem statements in various sectors are required to be addressed by a process where the students of the various colleges can be engaged in identification of solution to the problems, generate working on those areas, create organizations to generate employment and sustainability in the developing areas.

Hackathon is a thought process to encourage innovation amongst the students of different institutions through startup platform of the university and its affiliated colleges. A startup convention in the form of HACKATHON2018 was organized by Assam Science and Technology University (ASTU) under TEQIP III at the Institution of Engineers (India), Assam State center on 27th October 2018

- Students were supposed to submit one presentation, Bplan , to the email northeasthackathon@gmail.com and a google form filled by the students and participants during a specified date .

- 3. Students should take up a similar idea or similar project in different emerging technology like Agritech, Healthcare tech, Block chain, Artificial Intelligence, Internet of Things, Smart City developments and newer technologies.
- 4. Students can either submit on their own or submit their presentation with their team. (You may have 2-5 members to a team).
- 5. Registration and submission of the presentation were scheduled on or before 30th August as mandatory and no presentation was accepted beyond this date.



EVENT MANAGEMENT: The Hackathon event has been a three day programme starting from 2nd September to 4th September 2019.

About the Event:

The first ever Northeast Hackathon, organized by the Assam Science and Technology University on 2nd to 4th September 2019, has been a boon for the students in the region. The event was organized under the TEQIP-III program of Ministry of HRD, Government of India, in association with Startup Assam. As a first of its kind, the NE Hackathon has been tailored toward all students, with the focus on the five sectors pertinent to the region, including Textile and Handloom, Tourism, Water Management, Food Technology, and Energy, Environment and Sustainability. The three-day event saw the Prof. Gottipolu Rajarami Reddy, former Vice Chancellor, Vikrama Simhapuri University, Nellore, as the chief guest, who applauded this initiative made by the authorities at ASTU, as defining and a key to unlocking the hidden potential of the youth of the region. Prof. Pran Hari Talukdar (of The Assam Royal Global University and former professor of Guwahati Unniversity) was a distinguished guest. Other guests included Mr. Siddhartha Chowdhury (Founder of Credence Management Solution, Washington DC), and Dr. Nripen Das (Registrar, ASTU). Prof. (Dr.) V. G. Gaikar (Bharat Petroleum Professor and Head, Department of Chemical Engineering, Institute of Chemical Engineering) was also a guest on the closing ceremony on the 4th September, along with all the above mentioned dignitaries.

Hackathon is the brainchild of Prof. (Dr.) Dhiraj Bora, Honourable Vice Chancellor, ASTU. With the vision to create sustainable development across various sectors in the region, Dr. Bora has been fundamental behind the setup of this pioneering event in the Northeast.

The NE Hackathon has been a success at encouraging innovation amongst the students of various institutes. With the hope of instilling in them, the desire and courage to develop and inculcate the startup environment, its upgradation and incubation of students across different colleges of Northeast India; the Hackathon has led the way with the intention to create a sustainable development throughout.

A sporting activity full of brainstorming, the Hackathon consists of various workshops, competitions, expert training sessions etc. Participants were encouraged to take up a concept to solve the problem statements from one of the 5 focus areas, namely,

Tourism, Food Technology, Textile and Handloom, Water Management, and Energy, Environment and Sustainability. They have been encouraged and also scrutinized on the basis of their approach to the problems, their elevator pitches, and final presentations in front of a panel of eminent experts from various sectors, thus also pushing them onto a platform where their ideas can be heard.

One of the participants of this successful Hackathon 2019 believed that this initiative has been a very innovative in helping him, as well as many other budding entrepreneurs, to interact with like-minded people on a platform, that is aimed towards the economic growth of the region. He reiterated that the event was well-planned, and the participants had not been left wanting. With gap fillers like dance and song performances, their minds had been refreshed. The participant also said that although he had expected it to be a very hectic programme, the event was organised in such a manner that the all round health – physical, and mental, was kept in mind. While pushing them to do their best, the organizing authorities never exerted any undue and thus unhealthy pressure on the participants. There has been excellent feedback throughout and the authorities to be bigger and better next year.

With over 90 teams and 500 participants, Hackathon 2019 has been a fully packed event. MTU KANGLEITRONIC, a team comprising of five students from Manipur Technical University, won the competition. They had presented a business plan on "Solar Power Cold Storage cum Food dryer". Coincidentally, they were also rewarded the best disciplined team.

The second and third prizes were won by the teams from Indian Institute of Technology, Guwahati (IIT-G) and Girijananda Chowdhury Institute of Management and Technology, Guwahati, respectively. These top three teams were rewarded in the form of prize money – Rs 1,50,000, Rs 75,000 and Rs 50,000 respectively.

Prof. (Dr.) Dhiraj Bora has also conveyed his gratitude to all the participants for their overwhelming response and also encouraged them to pursue their passions and to work hard

Registration process: The students registered through a detailed check of their team participation. The volunteers of the hackathon arranged the details of accommodation and other related queries from the registration desk organised for the students.

A brief introduction of Financial aspects , Digital marketing , accountancy , IOT and Artificial Intelligence were discussed and shared by experts from the industry and interacted to motivate the participants of the industry .

The Vote of Thanks was shared by Dr. Nripen Kumar Das, Registrar , ASTU who welcomed the participants and encouraged for startup activities in the region .

The registrations of the competition for Hackathon where 11 out of the total registrations submitted were 25 .The competitions had two rounds of evaluation:

1. First round is a pitch presentation round where teams were asked to pitch infront of the judges in 2minutes time observed by a buzzer round.

2. Second Round is a PPT /Demo Presentation where teams were asked to present their demo / PPT in 10mins time observed by a buzzer round.

The competition is being judged by experts who have diversed background in the startup ecosystem.

There were different topics from students participating across the different Engineering colleges of Assam. The topics varied from integrated farming, mechanical seed planting machine, waste water solutions, asthivisarjan and different IOT based agritech models.
