## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

### PREAMBLE

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) made effective from the 29<sup>th</sup> Day of the November, 2019 is being signed between

Central Institute of Technology Kokrajhar, Assam, India established under the *Societies Registration Act, 1860* with its Registered Office at Vill. Balagaon, P.O. Rangalikhata – 783370, Distt. Kokrajhar (BTAD), Assam, India, hereinafter referred to as CITK,

and

Assam Science and Technology University located at Tetelia Road, Near Assam Engineering College, Jalukbari – 781013, Guwahati, Assam, India, hereafter referred to as ASTU,

for the purpose of

- (i) Enhancing the teaching, learning and research experiences of students and faculty in both the institutions in order to improve upon the quality of human resources available especially in Assam and the North-Eastern region of India;
- (ii) Facilitating joint collaborative work between students and faculty of the two institutions, and registration of research scholars of CITK in Assam Science and Technology University as per the University Rules and Regulations.

**Specifically, as governed by the Rules and Regulations of both the institutions,**

- (1) Faculty members/scientists in both the institutions may teach in either institution with prior approval of their parent institutions;
- (2) Faculty members/scientists in both the institutions may collaborate and jointly supervise research scholars in either institution;
- (3) The facilities of one institution will in principle be available to faculty members/scientists and research scholars of the other institution, the detailed modalities to be worked out on a case to case basis;
- (4) Both institutions shall endeavour to organize joint seminars, colloquium and other academic and outreach programs;
- (5) Both institutions shall endeavour to exchange relevant information in both academic and administrative matters;
- (6) Modalities for sharing of Intellectual Property Rights including applying for possible patents/publications for products developed as part of collaborative work between the two institutions should be agreed to in advance by the parties concerned, and approved by the appropriate authorities of both institutions;
- (7) This MoU shall have a term of five years from the date of execution, and may be modified from time to time by mutual agreement between the two institutions. This document is not meant to be a legally binding document, but is intended to provide a framework for promotion of co-operation and collaboration between the two institutions in the best interests of the students and faculty/scientists of both institutions, and the larger interests of the community and the State. This MoU shall not diminish the full autonomy of either institution, nor may any constraints be imposed by either institution upon the other;
- (8) The MoU may be renewed after this period of five years.
