MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

BETWEEN



ASSAM SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY UNIVERSITY, GUWAHATI

SRIMANTA SANKARADEVA UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES,

This MOU is entered on the 7th day of February, 2020 between Assam Science and Technology University, Guwahati (hereinafter called ASTU) situated at Guwahati, a State University under Government of Assam

And

Srimanta Sankaradeva University of Health Sciences, Guwahati (hereinafter called SSUHS), a State University under Government of Assam.

These Institutions hereinafter referred to individually as University.

1. Objectives of the MOU

The Objectives of the MOU are:

- To promote and enhance co-operation in education, research, technology transfer, man
 power training, curriculum development and other activities of the Universities.
- II. To exchange views and suggestions for improvement of quality of education.
- III. To promote research and continuing education activity between the two Universities.
- IV. To promote academic exchange of faculty and students, joint research program between the two Universities.

2. Scopes of the MOU

- I. This MOU sets the intentions of both the Universities for increased collaboration, co-operation and interaction and do not create any legally binding commitments. The legal commitments can be project specific that can be developed for specific purpose and when necessary. The MOU also covers the exchange of laboratory and other technical facilities between the two Universities.
- II. The affiliated colleges of both the Universities can also undertake study exchange and other programmes with the permission from the University authorities.
- III. Summer and winter training courses can be undertaken with exchange of students and faculties.
- IV. The training programs for the faculties can be held with mutual understandings.
- V. Recognition of research supervisors for UG, PG and PhD programmes can be undertaken between the two Universities.
- VI. The facilities of library, e-library and journals can be exchanged between the students and faculties of the two Universities (ASTU and SSUHS) within defined frameworks.

3. Terms and Conditions

- I. The cost involved for each and every activity as per the MOU will be mutually decided by both the Universities. It will be on the basis of percentage sharing.
- II. For training programmes, the cost will be borne by the host institutions.
- III. For student's exchange program, a part of the cost will be borne by the students also.
- IV. Both the Universities agree to help, identify and invite faculty members and research scholars from the other universities to participate in conferences, workshops and short term courses.
- V. The MOU may be amended, renewed and terminated by mutual written agreement at any time. The either University will have the right to terminate the MOU upon 60(Sixty) days prior written notice.
- VI. The Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) that may arise as a result of joint research and other collaborative activity will be shared by both the University on case to case basis and also according to prevailing IPR policies of the Govt. of India.

4. Confidentiality

ASTU and SSUHS agree to hold in confidence all information/data designated by the Universities as being confidential which is obtained from various sources of both the Universities during the performance of the MOU and will not disclose the same to any third party without written consent of the other University.

Effective date and duration. 5.

By written mutual consent, this agreement shall go into effect from the date it is signed by both the parties. This MOU will remain effective for a period of Five Years from the date of signing. However, the period of MOU can be extended on mutual agreement by both the Universities

6. Co-Ordinator

Both the Universities will designate persons who will have responsibilities for co-ordination and implementation of this MOU.

7. Signed in Duplicate:

This MOU is executed in duplicate with each copy being an official version and having equal legal validity. By signing below, the Universities, acting by their dully authorized Officers, have caused this Memorandum of Understanding to be executed, effective as of the day and year written above.
