MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

ASSAM SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY UNIVERSITY

AND.

INDIAN INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY GUWAHATI (IITG)

This non-binding Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") entered into effective as of by and between Assam Science and Technology University, having its registered office at Tetelia Road, Near Assam Engineering College, Jalukbari, Guwahati, Assam 781013and hereinafter unless the context otherwise requires be referred to as "ACADEMIC PARTNER"

and

Electronics & ICT Academy, located at Indian Institute of Technology Guwahati (IIT Guwahati), India, set up through a project grant by Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), Government of India for skill development and enhancement of employability in the area of Electronics, Information & Communication Technology and related areas, and hereinafter unless the context otherwise requires be referred to as "E&ICT ACADEMY".

Now therefore this MOU witnesses:

This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ("MOU") sets forth certain binding and non-binding understandings, is effective as of the later of the dates in the signature block ("Effective Date"), and is made and entered into by and between Assam Science and Technology University and E&ICT ACADEMY.

In furtherance of their mutual interest in the fields of training, education, research and development, and as a contribution to increased national cooperation, the ACADEMIC PARTNER having its registered address at Assam Science and Technology University and the E&ICT Academy, IIT Guwahati having its registered address at Guwahati, Assam, Pin Code – 781039.

ARTICLE I

The agreement between the parties involves collaboration between the at Assam Science and Technology University and the E&ICT Academy, IIT Guwahati in related disciplines.

The two organizations shall seek to promote:

- Collaboration in teaching and training either in kind or on paid basis as per the mutual agreement based on the subject, area, type (basic, advanced and research oriented) and duration of the courses in the area of Electronics, Information & Communication Technology and related areas.
 The courses might be conducted multiple times with academic participation as per the mutual convenience.
- Academic specific training programmes or courses should be promoted and hosted by E&ICT
 Academy with the active participation of the Academic Partners.
- Participation in the development of the courses and training modules for enhancing the employability for the registered Stakeholders.
- Collaboration in research and development, and consultancy works.
- The exchange of academic & research materials and joint publications.
- Cooperation in projects, research activities of mutual interest.
- Publication of Intellectual properties (IPs) developed jointly through project/research collaboration.
- · Participation in seminars, colloquia, and other types of academic discussions.

ARTICLE II

As per the proposal and the approved rate of program, **E&ICT Academy**, **IIT Guwahati** will be paying at **Assam Science and Technology University** Rs 1000 per hour. For example, for the class of 80 participants for a 80 Hrs. course, total amount to be paid to the **Assam Science and Technology University** will be Rs. 12.5x80 = Rs. 1000 per student. If the class size is of 40 students, the total sum paid would be Rs.500 per hour. Therefore, for 80Hrs of teaching, total sum paid will be Rs.500 x80 = Rs. 40,000. The Instructor/Faculty Member of the institute, monitoring the training will be paid Rs. 4.00 per participant per hour. For example, for an 80 Hrs. course against 40 participants, the Instructor/Faculty Member will be paid Rs. 4x40x80=Rs. 12800.

ARTICLE III

As per the proposal, the following are the terms and conditions to be followed:

- The Institute should be Science, Technology, Arts, Master of Application or Commerce oriented having strong IT background.
- 2. The Institute should have required infrastructure support as required by E&ICT Academy. The laboratory should have all the required equipment with a minimum sitting capacity of 40 students. The class room should have NKN/smart classroom with a minimum sitting capacity of 40 student's setup for conducting the classes across the different region of North east.
- The Institute in Science, Commerce, Arts, Master in Computer Application area should have courses running up to Master's Degree (preferably) or above.
- 5. The infrastructure provided by Academic Partners for the course execution are to be approved by the E&ICT Academy.
- 6. The E&ICT Academy reserves explicit right to choose Academic Partners for training program.
- 7. Academic Partners (established organizations or institutes in the area of Education) having MoU with the E&ICT Academy will be eligible for inviting the other Institutes to get associated with our training program. The E&ICT Academy reserves the right to choose them for training program explicitly.
- 8. The E&ICT Academy will be solely responsible for identifying courses which will be conducting throughout the year in association with Training Partners, companies and academic collaborators not only at IIT Guwahati alone but also at other geographic locations in North-East.
- 9. The E&ICT Academy reserves its right to choose Academic Partners suitable to any course in any location of mutual interest.
- Amendment to the eligibility criterion can only be made after taking prior approval of the competent authority.
- 11. Academic Partners will be informed by the E&ICT Academy for any changes, if made, in the mode of collaboration and operations.
- 12. The E&ICT Academy authorized Academic Partners will be allowed to contact other institutes or organizations for starting batches for training purposes either in kind or in revenue sharing basis. Examination of the courses will be conducted by the E&ICT Academy.

13. Teaching and training of participants to various courses at E&ICT Academy will be conducted by Academic partners either in kind or on paid basis as per the mutual agreement and based on the subject, area, type (basic, advanced and research oriented) and duration of the courses in the area of Electronics, Information & Communication Technology and related areas. The courses might be conducted multiple times with academic participation as per the mutual convenience.

ARTICLE IV

The implementation of cooperation based on this Memorandum shall be dealt with between both the organizations. Where necessary, a specific plan shall be worked out for each activity setting forth detailed arrangements for collaboration. Such plans shall be subject to the approval of the appropriate authorities of each organization. To facilitate the development of such plans, each organization shall nominate a member of its staff to coordinate activities arising under this agreement. Such plans are described in the annexes of this Memorandum of Understanding and should be the responsibility of the Faculty/Employee concerned.

ARTICLE V

Both Institutions agree and undertake to keep confidential at all times any information and/or data that may be exchanged, acquired and/or shared in connection with the area of cooperation as mentioned above in ARTICLE I (3) unless otherwise the same information already exists in the public domain.

ARTICLE VI

Ownership of any research findings shall be vested in both parties to this Memorandum and any publications regarding the same shall only be possible after prior approval from both parties.

ARTICLE VII

The Memorandum shall remain in force for a period of 05 (FIVE) years commencing from the date of signing and may be reviewed by mutual consent by serving 03 (Three) months written notice to the other party. Upon renewal, both parties shall select either to proceed with the existing or new terms of understanding.

ARTICLE VIII

Both the at Assam Science and Technology University and E&ICT Academy, IIT Guwahati reserve the right to terminate this Memorandum by either party giving 3 (Three) months written notice to the other. Where such termination occurs, the provisions of this Memorandum shall continue to apply to ongoing activities until their completion.

ARTICLE IX

Participating staff and students involved in any activities under this Memorandum must adhere to the law of the host countries and the rules and regulations of the host institutions.

ARTICLE X

The Assam Science and Technology University and E&ICT Academy, IIT Guwahati welcome the establishment of this Memorandum for cooperation and jointly agree to the provisions as set out above. There will be four copies of this Memorandum equally valid, two for each party, effective from the date of its signing.
